- visiting the church



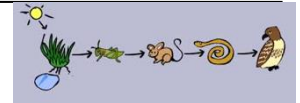
As athletes we will be:

- preparing for Sports Day



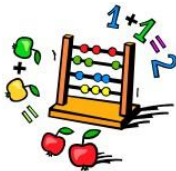
As scientists we will be:
