They had a wonderful talk from the museum curator, tried on Roman armour, handled lots of real and replica Roman artefacts and even got to feel the weight of a roman sword and shield! They explored the excavated granaries and bath house and enjoyed the most picturesque picnic overlooking the River Ribble. The trip was an excellent opportunity for the children to demonstrate their current knowledge as well as supporting their real-world experience of local history.

 - 2. Name of medicine


