## Spellings:

We now have a subscription to the website 'spelling shed' which is an online spelling programme which includes games and tests for the children. As teachers, we will set the words we wish your child to learn and they can log in on a computer or tablet to practice as often as they wish. Your child will be given a personal login in their reading diaries which must not be shared with anybody else.

**Reading books and library books** will be changed each Friday. We expect Year 2 children to write their own dates and book titles in their diaries at home. Please refer to the note on the inside cover of your child's reading diary for more information.

**Homework:** Each Friday there will be a short piece of homework that will be linked to your child's class work. Children that bring their homework in by the following Friday will be rewarded with a green card!
