A few requests:

Please name **EVERYTHING** your child wears or brings to school. Do not forget coats, shoes (no laces unless your child can tie them), vests, gloves and scarves!

OUTDOOR AREA

As part of the curriculum the children have access to the Outdoor Area everyday, whatever the weather. Please ensure your child has a coat at school everyday as the area can be quite cold even on a sunny day. To save wearing out school shoes quickly we are requesting that each child has their own pair of **NAMED WELLINGTONS** at school all the time. For Health and Safety reasons please do not allow children on the outdoor play equipment before or after school.

EVENTS

We are very sorry but at the moment, due to Covid restrictions we are unable to plan any of our usual events where parents are invited into school but we will advise you of any planned events should these restrictions change.

SCHOOL BAGS

If possible please send your child to school with a small A4 sized bag for carrying books and letters as required. Please note we do not have room in our book boxes/cloakrooms for rucksacks. Please remember to name the bag on the outside if possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Classroom doors open at 8.45am (following the times on website regarding Covid safety restrictions) and close at 9.00am. If your child arrives after 9.00am they must enter school through the Infant office.

Children not collected from the classroom by 3.25pm will be taken to the infant office for collection. If you know you are going to be late please ring school to let us know on 01253 763601.

If your child is absent from school for any reason please let the office know as soon as possible on the above number. Please follow latest Blackpool Covid guidelines (usually sent by text) if you are unsure whether to send your child if they are unwell.

If your child has a medical appointment during school hours please show the office confirmation of the appointment e.g. appointment card/letter and let them know how long your child will be away from school.

PE – children are not permitted to wear earrings for any PE activity. Although we are not changing for PE at the moment we will be carrying out some of our activities in the hall so please ensure all earrings are removed before school on the day your child has PE.
