Homework

We have been thrilled with the effort the children are putting in to ensure that they are reading at least three times a week at home. Along with our bookworm badges awards, our Golden Ticket box is bursting with new books to earn in exchange for reading. Children are expected to read aloud **daily** at home, please can you continue to make sure that your child's reading diary has been signed at least three times each week so the children can receive their awards in school. If the children have only read part of a book please could you indicate in their diary the pages they have read. Children's reading books will continue to be changed weekly on a Friday. However, children are expected to bring their reading book and diary to school on a daily basis.

Spellings will continue to be given out weekly on a Monday. These will then be tested the following Monday. Please can children remember to bring their spelling books to school every Monday. It is really important that these spellings are practised at home so that the children learn the rule and then apply this to their writing. All the children have access to Spelling Shed which has their weekly spellings on along with other games to help with their spellings.

The children are working hard with their weekly times table challenges. The children have access to Times Table Rock Stars to help them learn their times tables.

One piece of homework will be given weekly/fortnightly (on a Monday) which will be due in the following Monday.

To help the children with their Maths, work will also be set on MyMaths.

Extra Support

This term we welcome Mr Bennett to our teaching team. Over the term, Mr Bennett will work in all the classes across the Year Group.

This will enable your child's class teacher to work with your child within a very small group setting to provide extra tailored support to their learning.
