Homework in Year 2

Spellings:

The children have been given a copy of their weekly spellings for the Summer term and we have asked them to keep these in a safe place as they will need to learn them every week for an informal test on a **Friday**. This term we are focusing on tricky 'red words' and alternative sound spellings. Each week, the new spelling words will be set on Spelling Shed (www.edshed.com) where your child can login using their personal passwords and practice spelling these words via fun games.

Reading books will be changed **each Friday** so please ensure your child has their reading books and diaries in their bags on this day. Please refer to the note on the inside cover of your child's reading diary for more information. Each week, pupils bring home a paper bookmark to complete comprehension questions about their books to develop their understanding of the text as well as their decoding skills. They receive green cards for returning these completed.

Library books will be changed **when they have been read on Fridays**.

Homework: Each **Friday** your child's homework will be uploaded onto Seesaw, our online learning platform. Their personal login for this will be in their reading diaries.

Paper copies of the homework tasks can be given for any children without online access. Please let your child's teacher know if this is the case. All homework is to be completed/returned for the following Friday to earn green cards!
