Please sign your child's diary so it is clear that they have read to an adult. It would be appreciated if you could discuss the what they have read and explore any unfamiliar vocabulary with them.

Homework: This will be given out every week, on a **Thursday**. Usually, they will be given a piece of Maths homework and a piece of English homework. Sometimes, we may set a project for the children based on our current learning. Please ensure that all homework is completed to a high standard and that it is in on time, otherwise your child will go to homework catchup on a Friday lunchtime.
