## FAREWELL

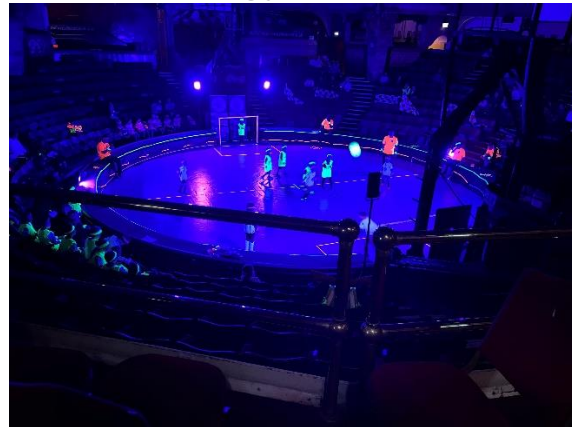
